

The Role of the Cluster Support Group Coordinator

Cluster Coordinators are self-appointed to lead a cluster of schools registered with OCR to use Asset Languages qualifications. They coordinate the meetings of the cluster of schools. Typically a cluster would comprise about ten centres situated in a geographical area.

The role of Cluster Coordinator is to provide support to teachers of Asset Languages by facilitating meetings which will:

- provide a forum for exchange of ideas and networking
- promote good practice in teaching, learning and assessment for the qualifications concerned
- provide an effective channel of communication between schools and Asset Languages

In order to meet these requirements Cluster Coordinators will be invited to an annual meeting. This meeting will provide support to those facilitating cluster group meetings.
